

## 19. The Time

Common phrases related to time:

**¿Qué hora es?**

**Es la una.**

**Son las dos, las tres, las diez...**

What time is it?

It is one o'clock

It is two, three, ten o'clock...

Use **cuarto** and **media** to say "quarter hour" and "half hour":

**y cuarto**

**menos cuarto**

**y media**

**Es la una menos cuarto.**

**Son las seis y media.**

quarter past

quarter to + the hour

half past

It is quarter to one.

It is half past six or It is six thirty.

Use **a la** and **a las** to say when you are doing something at a specific time.

**Regreso a casa a las ocho y media.**

**Todos los días como a la una.**

**¿Cuándo?**

**Por la mañana.**

**Por la tarde.**

**Por la noche.**

**temprano**

**tarde**

**llegar temprano/tarde**

I go back home at half past eight or eight thirty.

I have lunch everyday at one o'clock.

When?

In the morning.

In the afternoon.

In the evening./At night.

early

late

to be early/late
